

# Clip-on Butterfly

This is a good craft to make with young children.

Equipment needed:

- Wooden clothes pegs
- Glue (double-sided sticky tape will do as well)
- Scissors
- Butterfly template (samples on next page)
- Paint or colouring pens/crayons

To make the craft, first create the template to use. There are two on the next page which can be used or modified as you wish. Cut the butterflies out ready for colouring. If you are using paint, fold the butterflies in half and paint a pattern on the one side only. Simply fold over the unpainted half onto the painted half, press down for a few seconds and then open up. You should have a nice matching pattern on both wings.

If you are using colouring pens or crayons then you will have to carefully colour both wings to try to match as much as possible.

Once coloured in and dry, glue (or tape) the centre of the butterfly onto one side of the clothes peg. You can now clip the butterfly onto curtains, clothes etc!
